A variety of sceneries for open air activities lovers, a land preserved by mysterious standing stones for curious visitors, a multitude of local taste for gourmets, a low mountain range to get fresh air on summer and enjoy snowy landscapes on winter, but also and moreover, a place to be to relax and forget the daily life !

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Zoom on... The CAROUX !



The Caroux is the eastern end of the Espinouse Mountains, in the heart of the Haut-Languedoc Regional Natural Park. It consists of a plateau that culminates at an altitude of 1091 meters and is limited to the west by the gorges of Héric, to the east by the gorges of Colombières and to the south by the Orb valley. This mountain of mystery remains a treasure in our landscape where the gold of the broom, the fushia of the heather and the green of the forests mingle: an incomparable and unique spectacle for visitors !

Privileged land of adventures, it is the favourite place for climbing enthusiasts, hikers and also for the Royal Eagle and the Mediterranean «Mouflon» ! This emblematic animal is now the master of the place ! Introduced

between 1956 and 1960, in one of the wildest valleys of the Caroux massif, the Mediterranean mouflon population is today one of the largest in France!

The Caroux is locally called the "lying woman" because of its shape that recalls a woman's body. According to legend, Cebenna, the Titans' daughter, was damned by Zeus to hope for love without ever reaching it. Filled with sorrow, she came to the top of the mountain to die. Nature, moved by her fate, made her a jewel case for eternity. Thus the body of Cebenna lends forever its shape to the Caroux massif and hers tears form the stream of Héric that still flows today.



Holidays 100% NATURE

Take a breath of fresh air in Monts & Lacs in Haut-Languedoc! Dream destination for hiking: explore our territory on foot, on two wheels or on horseback. Amateurs of strong sensations, you will be delighted to climb equr mid-mountain massifs. As for those who are hooked, there is no shortage of lakes and rivers!

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Hiking

Located in the heart of the Haut-Languedoc Regional Natural Park, our destination is a privileged place for hiking. Between Caroux, Espinouse and Monts de Lacaune, qualified trails from 1h to 8h30 walk take you in the woods, on the edge of lakes and streams or on the summits of the departments of Hérault and Tarn . Whether you are a fan of walking or a Sunday hiker, you will surely find your happiness among more than 30 hiking tours (400 km) that criss-cross our territory.

Hiking for several days is also possible! The «En suivant l'Enfant Sauvage» circuit (52 km) reserves 3 days of roaming between Lacaune, La Salvetat and Laouzas. The GR de Pays «Hautes Terres d'Oc» (10 days hiking) and «Montagne du Haut-Languedoc» (20 days hiking) will delight the most experienced walkers!

Hiking sheets and topoguides are available at the tourist information offices.



The way of Saint Jacques de Compostelle

The Way of Arles (or Via Tolosana) is one of the oldest paths of Saint James listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Since several centuries, pilgrims and hikers have been making this pilgrimage to repair their faults or sins ... but also out of a taste for trial, challenge or achievement !

The Via Tolosana crosses a part of our territory. From Saint-Gervais-sur-Mare, the road stops at Murat-sur-Vèbre, La Salvetat-sur-Agoût and finally at Anglès. This 42 km stretch hides exceptional natural landscapes as well as a rich cultural heritage: the chapel of Sainte Eutrope in Castanet-le-Haut, the apse of the church of Saint-Etienne de Murat, the Black Virgin «Notre Dame d'Entraygues» in La Salvetat-sur-Agoût...

Each stop offers accommodation (gîtes d'étape, hotels, chambres d'hôtes ...) to enjoy a well deserved rest and regain strength !



Cycle tourism

You like to take your time? Admire the landscapes? Discover the cultural heritage? Put on your helmet and go for a cyclo ride! Lakes, viewpoints, a wash house, a standing stone ... Our tours (from 24 to 73 km) hold a lot of surprises for you! Keep your eyes open !

VTT

Straddling the departments of Tarn and Hérault, our destination is lucky enough to have not one but two areas with the VTT-FFC label: "Hautes Terres d'Oc" (n°8) and "La Salvetat Haut-Languedoc" (n°55). Mountain biking in the Monts & Lacs in Haut-Languedoc means hurtling down more than 50 marked trails (1300 km) in the middle of hilly landscapes or on downhill tracks!

and mane companions to combine holidays and passion. Donkey rides, horse rides, initiations, carriage rides ... Saddle up!





Fishing

A must to do sport in the Monts & Lacs of Haut-Languedoc, fishing takes its place throughout the destination. Six lakes and streams are classified in the 1st category (Vésoles, Agoût, Dadou, Vèbre, Gijou and Arn), two of them allow this practice all year round (The Laouzas and Saints-Peyres) and one is classified as «large inland lake and mountain lake» (La Raviège). Here you will engage in all types of fishing: night carp, lake, river, fly, no-kill ... whether you are beginners, specialists or with reduced mobility (pontoons)! Teasing fish, it is also for children! In ponds, on fishing paths made for the youngest, in fish farms ... , ask for your fishing gear and enjoy a «fishing» moment with your family!



Climbing

Wild landscapes, an altitude of medium mountains ... climb peaks in Monts & Lacs in Haut-Languedoc ! Our destination, especially the Caroux massif, is of unique interest for climbing and mountaineering. Famous climbers made their ascent there : Fraissinet, Azéma, Desmaison, Flematti ...

Not to be missed : the climbing school site of «La Fage», its paths accessible to beginners and its stream to cool off after the effort !



Canyoning

Canyoning is a combination of swift water walking, swimming, abseiling and crossing of slides... It's great fun to follow the bed of a river encased in beautiful and amazing places, almost inaccessible otherwise. Some professionals can also design a tour to your specifications : with your family, sports lovers, those looking for thrills...

Triathlons & Trails

Are you sporty? Do you like challenges? Choose our destination to push back your limits! This year, three major sporting events:

the Fitdays mgen (July), the Trail de la Raviège (August) and the Charcu' trails (September).

Races in the wilderness

Long ascents and descents, varied and rugged terrain, sometimes snowy peaks, and nature as far as the eye can see ... You are in the middle of the mountains : the ideal playground for trail riding!

The FITdays mgen 2020

For the third consecutive year, the Fitdays mgen stop in Monts & Lacs in Haut-Languedoc. This major event highlights the benefits of a sport and triathlon in particular. This discipline has three steps : swimming in open water, a cycling course and finally, a running race. From 10 to 14 July, the champions of the discipline, as well as the insiders or beginners, will push back their limits around the lake of the Raviège in La Salvetat-sur-Agoût and the lake of Laouzas in Nages. The mgen Fitdays is also an opportunity to practise sports with your family ! The youngest athletes will be able to team up with their parents, grandparents, brothers and sisters, or even learn to eat better and move better, separate waste and even become a firefighter in the Village «sport-santé» !

Leisure parks The Monts & Lacs in Haut-Languedoc register four leisure parks. You want to let off steam and practice water activities ? Head off the leisure park of the lake of Laouzas (Nages) or of the Bouldouïres (La Salvetat-sur-Agoût). You would rather be far from the crowd and just want to cool off ? Spread your bath towel at the leisure park of the Gua des Brasses (La Salvetat-sur-Agoût). You come with your family and look for outdoors games to keep busy your ittle darlings ? Go to the leisure park of the Rabaudié (Viane).

L'Espace des Sources Chaudes

Open all year round, this leisure and sports swimming pool is fed by naturally hot spring water formerly used for the thermal baths of Lacaune-les-bains. Inside, paddling pool, water mushroom . . . for the «pitchouns». For older ones, swimming lines and fitness and balneo areas.

In summer, the outdoor pool with its spring water leaves your skin feeling soft! Bubble benches, a river with a current, without forgetting the slide and the pentagliss, . . . will please everyone ! Finally, the beautiful lawns and deckchairs are just waiting for you for a lazy break!



Outdoor swimming pools

A swimming pool in the middle of the trees or on the edge of a lake, it is possible! From mid-June to mid-September, take advantage of the heated paddling pool or swimming pool while enjoying the sublime view of the Lac du Laouzas and its peninsula. In the summer, at the Bouldouïres beach, refresh yourself in the outdoor pool and its multiple pools (paddling pool, medium and large) or sunbathe on its sunny terrace. Are you spending your vacation with small children? The small heated pool of the Rabaudié, open in July and August, is made for you!

Our museums



Filature Ramond Open from June 15 to September 15.

Immerse yourself in the atmosphere of an 1841 spinning mill. Your guide will operate, in front of you, machines from the 19th century, always in working order.



Musée des battages à l'ancienne Open from June to September, by appointment.

In addition to the small agricultural equipment of the period, this museum area displays 110 tractors dating from 1921 to the 1960s.

Tours du château de Nages Open in July and August.

Climb up the majestic staircase of the Count of Thézan's castle to reach two beautiful rooms and a round tower.



Conservatoire du presbytère de Tastavy Open in July and August.

Discovery of the Catholic religious heritage of yesterday and today, in the Monts d Lacaune and Haut-Languedoc area.



Maison du Mouflon et du Caroux Open from mid-April to mid-September. The ecosystems, the environment, the flora, the fauna (including the majestic mouflon)... The Caroux massif will no longer hold any secrets for you !





Maison de la Charcuterie Open from June 15 to September 15. Lacaune's charcuterie has been made and enjoyed for several centuries. Discover

its fascinating history!

Musée du Vieux Lacaune Open from mid-May to September . Discover the daily life of Lacaune inhabitants from 1700 to 1945 (reconstructions of life scenes) through 15 exhibition rooms.





Musée des voitures anciennes **Open all year round, by appointment.** Visit of a private collection of about twenty cars dating from the 20s to the 70s.



Salaisons Oberti Open from mid-February to mid-November. Museum of the manufacture of Lacaune ham and exhibition of old machines, equipment and period objects.



Musée de la vie paysanne Open from May to September. Site dedicated to the conservation and transmission of rural

heritage. Geology, ancient know-how. . . go back in time!

Open all year round by appointment Exhibition of more than 6000 miniature vehicles, to be discovered in the village.



From statue-menhirs to mute goddesses

Land of legends and mysteries, the Monts & Lacs in Haut-Languedoc are adorned with one of the oldest megalithic statues in Europe. Sculpted and erected more than 5000 years ago, our statue-menhirs have been the silent witnesses of the life of the first inhabitants of our region, the first sedentary farmers, farmers and breeders of whom our current farmers are the worthy descendants. Sometimes feminine, sometimes masculine, eroded by thousands of years, they remain the guardians of their secrets . . .







For more information ...

In Murat-sur-Vèbre, the Centre for the Interpretation of Megaliths unveils all their mysteries to you! Come and discover the life of Neolithic men and women, the first farmers and stockbreeders at the end of Prehistory and admire about fifteen of their stone works. A discovery circuit (to be done by car) will also allow you to go in search of these «mute goddesses» who mark out the Mounts & Lakes in Haut-Languedoc. **The Megalith Interpretation Centre is open all year round.**

A terroir, a know-how : an ideal combination to offer quality and seasonal products, some of which are recognised by labels. In Monts & Lacs in Haut-Languedoc, as we say in France "every parts is good in in the pig" !



Delicatessen and cured meats

Situated on the historic "Salt Route" and subject to three climatic influences, our destination is the land of charcuterie. Here, we make everything: fresh products, cooked (bougnettes, melsats, fritons. . .) but especially dried (salted meats). Lacaune Ham, with its melt-in-the-mouth texture and nutty taste, is the noblest expression of this and shares its success with sausage and salami. All three have moreover obtained, in 2015, an official sign of European quality: the Protected Geographical Indication. Two years later, the town of Lacaune-les-Bains was awarded the "Site remarquable du goût" label. Here, we "make charcuterie" as a family! The Millas and Oberti Houses welcome you to discover and taste their specialities during a visit.

Drinks

A little thirsty? Our destination offers you several waters: Mont Roucous, low mineral content and particularly recommended for mothers and babies, and La Salvetat, finely sparkling, to be consumed during meals as well as throughout the day. For tea-time, a sweet touch: apple juice. Happy hour already? Treat yourself to a homemade beer (La "Saint Victor" produced in Nages or "La Montéliote" in Lamontelarié), unless you prefer a "Black Mountain" whisky. Consume in moderation !

Cheese

Roquefort cheese, you have certainly already eaten some, but did you know that it is made exclusively from the milk of the Lacaune ewe? Bred on our land, this hardy breed is recognizable by its wool that covers only the upper parts of its body.

Goats and cows also go across our green meadows to offer us typical cheeses, to be enjoyed at the end of the meal, with jam for breakfast or in winter as raclette cheese !
